CANA CONGREGATIONS' OPPOSITION TO MOTION FOR BRIEFING SCHEDULE AND LEAVE TO FILE A REPLY BRIEF

The CANA Congregations (The Falls Church, Truro Church, Church of the Apostles, Church of the Epiphany, St. Margaret's Church, St. Stephen's Church, and St. Paul's Church (hereafter collectively the "CANA Congregations")) by counsel, hereby oppose the Motion for Briefing Schedule and Leave to File a Reply Brief, and state:

1. There is already a briefing schedule in place for the Diocese's Motion for Award of Prejudgment Interest. The Diocese filed its motion, with memorandum, on January 23, 2012. The hearing is scheduled for February 16, 2012. Pursuant to Rule 4:15 (c) of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Virginia, the Congregations' opposing memorandum is due to be filed by February 9, 2012. The Diocese has not proffered any good reason for this Court to vary the general procedure set forth by Rule 4:15 (c) and thereby to reduce the Congregations' time to file their opposition. The Congregations request that the parties be required to follow the briefing schedule set forth in Rule 4:15 (c), which provides ample briefing for a motion of this nature.

- 2. From time to time in this case, this Court has set a briefing schedule. In doing so, this Court has recognized the inherent fairness of simultaneous briefs which provided for the sides to have the opportunity to file the same number of briefs with the same number of pages. The Diocese's procedure for filing its motion has prevented the court from ordering simultaneous briefs. However, the Diocese has not presented any good reason for this Court to set aside its procedure of providing for equal briefs with equal pages for each side. The Congregations request that the Diocese's Motion to Set Briefing Schedule and for Leave to File Reply Brief be denied so that each side will have one brief and an equal allotment of pages.
- 3. As a practical matter, the Congregations request the full standard amount of time to complete and file their opposition. The Congregations and their counsel are currently responsible for analyzing and responding to this Court's Letter Opinion, responding to demands from the Diocese, reviewing the terms of a prospective Final Order, and planning for transition from the properties. This Court has consistently required the Congregations to file consolidated pleadings which the Congregations have willingly done in the interests of efficiency. However, the process of filing consolidated pleadings usually requires additional time as numerous counsel in five different law firms must review and approve the final form prior to filing. The Congregations only request that their deadline of February 9, 2012 under Rule 4:15 (c) not be shortened.
- 4. The Diocese claims that this is an important issue, that it believes that the Congregations will oppose the motion and that the Diocese should have leave to file a reply brief so the Court will have full briefing. These claims all ring hollow. The Diocese originally noticed this motion in a manner which would not have allowed time for a reply brief. The Diocese did not request a special briefing schedule before or at the time of the filing of the motion. The issue is certainly important but it has not become any more important since the

Diocese filed its motion. The Congregations will, indeed, oppose the Diocese's motion but the likelihood of opposition has not increased since the Diocese filed its motion. Finally, any need for full briefing for the Court has not increased since the Diocese filed its motion.

WHEREFORE, The CANA Congregations respectfully request that the Diocese's Motion for Briefing Schedule and Leave to File a Reply Brief be denied.
