**THE FALLS CHURCH ANGLICAN'S MOTION TO ENFORCE FINAL ORDER**

The Falls Church Anglican (hereinafter "TFCA"), by counsel, without waiving any assignment of error or issue on appeal now pending before the Supreme Court of Virginia, moves this Court for enforcement of the Final Order entered in this consolidated matter on March 1, 2012, with respect to the Protestant Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Virginia's (hereinafter "Diocese") responsibility for personal property and related contractual benefits and obligations transferred by TFCA pursuant to the Order.

TFCA respectfully requests that the Court enforce its March 1, 2012 Final Order by (1) ordering that the Diocese pay the outstanding balance for the "iCORE" system contract and assume all rights and obligations as the "customer" pursuant to that contract, (2) award TFCA its costs and attorneys' fees associated with this Motion to Enforce Final Order, and (3) award such further relief as the Court deems necessary and appropriate.



**THE FALLS CHURCH ANGLICAN'S MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES IN SUPPORT OF ITS MOTION TO ENFORCE FINAL ORDER**

The Falls Church Anglican (hereinafter "TFCA"), by counsel, submits this Memorandum of Points and Authorities in Support of its Motion to Enforce Final Order, and respectfully states as follows:

This Motion seeks enforcement of the Court's Final Order with respect to the telephone/internet system in place at the Falls Church. That system has been conveyed to the Diocese as specifically required by the Court's Final Order. Pursuant to the Final Order and Exhibit G which is explicitly included therein, the phone system, its components, and all related contracts were transferred to the Diocese. TFCA complied with the Final Order. The Diocese, however, has accepted the phone system, but has disavowed and refused to pay for the associated service contract. Despite the specific provisions of the Final Order and despite the Diocese's having taken possession of the equipment at 115 E. Fairfax Street, the Diocese argues that TFCA must pay to service a system it does not own. As is further detailed below, the Diocese's position is contrary to the Final Order.

TFCA entered into an agreement with iCORE for a telephone system at 115 E. Fairfax Street after December 16, 2006, but prior to the “Ownership Demarcation Date” of January 31, 2007. Phones and internet system equipment were put in place, and the service contract with iCORE for the phone system was effective when the system went on line on January 20, 2007. TFCA renewed the service agreement, most recently on December 19, 2011.

TFCA had no way of knowing that the Court would use anything other than December 16, 2006 as the demarcation date for possession of property, and that it would be required to convey the phone system. In fact TFCA filed a Motion for Reconsideration as to the demarcation date, and the Diocese opposed the date’s modification. Further, TFCA filed a Motion to Stay Enforcement of the Judgment so that it might remain in possession of the property during the pendency of the appeal in this matter, and the Diocese likewise opposed the same.

Importantly, the phones and other tangible system equipment are linked to the iCORE Service Agreement. Just like a residential cable box, the phone equipment requires related service. Likewise, service from iCORE without the equipment needed to use the service is pointless.

On March 1, 2012 the Court entered the Final Order in this consolidated matter, which provides that The Episcopal Church (hereinafter “TEC”) and the Diocese “have contractual and proprietary interests in the real and personal property at issue in this litigation.” (Final Order at

1). Section D of the Final Order provides in pertinent part:

On or before April 30, 2012, the defendant trustees and the CANA Congregations shall (1) convey to the Bishop of the Diocese all of their respective rights, titles and interests in the tangible and intangible personal property identified in Exhibit G attached hereto (other than liquid personal property that is the subject matter of paragraph E of this Order) and excepting after acquired property identified in Exhibit L attached hereto

(*Id.*)(emphasis added).

TFCA conveyed real and personal property to the Diocese pursuant to the Final Order. “Exhibit G” to the Final Order, which details the property to be conveyed to the Diocese from TFCA is expressly made part of the Court’s Order. Exhibit G begins, “This Final Order encompasses any and all tangible and intangible property acquired by the CANA Congregations as of the applicable Ownership Determination Date.” *See* Exhibit G. Importantly, Exhibit G and the items of tangible and intangible property to be conveyed were negotiated by the parties in advance of being *ordered* by the Court. Phone systems, such as the iCORE system in place were specifically identified in the Final Order/Exhibit G.<sup>1</sup>

As such, the iCORE phone system located at 115 E. Fairfax Street was conveyed to the Diocese along with possession of all the personal property on the premises. The negotiated and ordered inventory list identified numerous handsets, switches, and equipment, in addition to the numerous “Phone Lines.” (*See* Ex. G). Further, the service contract requirement was explicitly identified as being necessarily linked to the phone system. The following note alerted the Diocese to the equipment’s dependence on the iCORE service and was repeated throughout Exhibit G:

NOTE 2: iCORE provides the service of the phone system on the premises. The Diocese will not be able to use the telephone system unless it picks up the contract with iCORE.

(*See* Exhibit G).

On or about June 15, 2012, counsel for the Diocese inquired about obtaining passwords to access the iCORE phone system. The Diocese’s IT representative was advised that the passwords for the iCORE phone system were maintained by iCORE Networks, Inc., as part of its

service contract and that TFCA could not provide the passwords as it no longer possessed the phone system.

The Diocese is in possession of the phone system, but has repeatedly refused to assume the obligation to pay for phone service under the iCORE contract. TFCA made every effort to ensure an orderly transition regarding use of the iCORE phone system pursuant to Section F of the Final Order.

TFCA forwarded a copy of the July invoice covering phone service from June 15 – 30, 2012, to the Diocese to assist in the transition of the iCORE phone service. In response the Diocese indicated that it would not pay the invoice or take over the service agreement. Now, the Diocese's failure to make payments under the agreement has led to iCORE accusing TFCA of breaching the service contract. The Diocese now maintains that TFCA should pay iCORE for service that is inextricably linked to the phones and equipment that TFCA was ordered to convey to the Diocese and which the Diocese accepted and owns.

In accordance with the Final Order, TFCA conveyed the iCORE phone system equipment at 115 E. Fairfax Street to the Diocese as required. TFCA also conveyed the documentation related to the iCORE service agreement as envisioned and required by Exhibit G. The Diocese is in possession of the real and personal property at 115 E. Fairfax Street, which included the phone system its component parts, and the service contract. The phone and internet equipment that was conveyed require service. The Final Order does not contain any exception whereby the Diocese would be entitled to possession of the iCORE phone system but not obligated to iCORE Networks for the necessary service of that system. The Diocese's contention that TFCA should pay for such service while the Diocese owns the associated phone system is baseless and illogical.



TFCA obtained the iCORE phone system and entered the service agreement at issue prior to the demarcation date. The Diocese was awarded possession of the phone system, and also takes the rights and obligations of the associated service agreement. While TFCA has renewed the iCORE agreement, there is little question that the renewal relates back to the original contract. The same phone system has remained in place since January 20, 2007 as have the essential terms of the agreement. The Supreme Court of Virginia has recognized that renewal of a contract can relate back to the original transaction. *W.R. Long v. Laura A. Mayo*, 156 Va. 185, 157 S.E. 767 (1931). In *W.R. Long*, Mr. Long purchased company stock from George Mayo. The purchase was made on credit and Mr. Long executed a note payable to Mr. Mayo. The note was renewed from time to time, but when Mr. Mayo became ill nearly ten (10) years later, Mrs. Mayo issued correspondence to the Defendant regarding the debt, and confirming renewal of the note. The Court noted that such renewal related back to the original transaction and the terms entered into between Mr. Mayo and Defendant. *W.R. Long*, 156 Va. At 190.

Further, as the phone system requires the associated service agreement in order to be functional and/or beneficial in any way, service agreement renewals were necessary to preserve the asset of a comprehensive office phone system. Had TFCA allowed the service to lapse during the pendency of the litigation the Diocese would have received telephone equipment and hardware capable of nothing more than serving as paper-weights.

TFCA has complied with the Final Order and conveyed the iCORE phone system and contract that were in place prior to the demarcation date. TFCA alerted the Diocese during the transition of property that the phone system was linked to the iCORE service, and inoperable without same. There is no basis to require TFCA to pay for service of a system which is in full possession of the Diocese.

For all the reasons stated herein, TFCA respectfully requests the Court Enforce the Final

Order as to the iCORE service agreement.

## **Exhibit G (Tangible and Intangible Personal Property)**

This Final Order encompasses any and all tangible and intangible personal property owned by the CANA Congregations as of the applicable Ownership Determination Dates. To the extent that there is any individually owned personal property located on the CANA Congregation premises, that property is excluded from the scope of the Final Order. The congregation specific inventories and/or property descriptions attached hereto include but are not limited to the following (unless otherwise excepted), which are intended to be descriptive and encompass reasonably related items even if not specifically identified:

1. Parish Registers and other documents reflecting membership;
2. Cemetery plats and records;
3. Historical documents, archives, and photographs;
4. Sacred objects such as chalices, plates, cups, bowls, censers, and linens associated with worship;
5. Altar items, altar ware, sets, candles, and candle holders;
6. Crosses and crucifixes;
7. Eucharistic items;
8. Holy water items and Baptismal Fonts;
9. Artwork, stained glass, prints, certificates, and plaques;
10. Clergy robes and vestments not individually owned;
11. Prayer books, hymnals, and Bibles not individually owned;
12. Pillows, cushions, and kneelers;
13. Statuary items and stations;
14. Pulpits, pews, and altar chairs;
15. Library materials and books;
16. Episcopal Signage;

17. Office equipment, including but not limited to computers, hard drives, software, copiers, and facsimile/telephone systems;
18. Non-privileged vestry and other committee and congregational meeting minutes and records;
19. Vehicles, titles, registrations, and maintenance records;
20. Musical equipment, instruments, and sheet music;
21. Sound equipment, including but not limited to microphones, speakers, and soundboards;
22. Kitchen equipment, including but not limited to kitchenware, microwaves, and stoves;
23. Audiovisual equipment, including but not limited to projectors, televisions, and VCRs;
24. Furniture, furnishings, and antiques not individually owned;
25. Sunday school materials;
26. Nursery and preschool toys, games, playground equipment, and educational tools;
27. Tools, machinery, and lawn care equipment;
28. Building maintenance equipment;
29. Fixtures, trade fixtures, goods and inventory of all kinds.
30. Copies or originals, as available, of all documents, materials and records relating to the ownership, operation, use and/or financing of the real property to be conveyed by the Churches, including, without limitation, fixture, equipment and other property inventories, title insurance policies and underlying recorded and unrecorded title documents, surveys and plats, other contracts, site plan approvals, building permits, certificates of occupancy, other permits, license and approvals, loan documents, including, without limitation, all security agreements and deeds of trust, plans and

specifications, warranties, maintenance contracts, O & M manuals, termite and other wood-boring insect reports and warranties, physical condition reports, environmental site assessments, wetlands assessments, geotechnical and other soil reports, utilities records and information, insurance policies, and leases, subleases, licenses and other agreements with respect to possession or use.

31. Negotiable and non-negotiable instruments; promissory notes; money and securities; certificates of deposit; safe deposit boxes, keys, and items therein; stock certificates, ownership interests in joint ventures and partnership agreements; and any and all financial records, instruments, items and assets defined and recognized by the Virginia Uniform Commercial Code;
32. Causes of action, rights of action, choses in action, and claims of every type, manner or description;
33. Insurance policies and claims excepting and Directors and Officers policies and any policies or claims related to this litigation;
34. Non-privileged files, whether physical or electronic, including any in storage and/or on backup disks;
35. Passwords and keycodes for any master key system or other accounts;
36. Keys to all doors, file cabinets, desks, and vehicles;
37. Contracts, agreements, purchase orders, leases, license agreements, letters of intent, and/or other documents memorializing any agreement(s) maintained by, relating to or associated with the church; and
38. Intellectual property, general intangible property, and related proprietary rights, interests and protections, however arising (excepting any such property, rights, interests and protections that are owned by individuals).
