

Annual Report Form for Non-Parochial Clergy

Non-Parochial Clergy are priests or bishops (retired or not retired) who are not assigned to a congregation in the Diocese of Virginia and who do not have a Letter of Agreement signed by the Bishop during a portion of the calendar year. These clergy are required by canon (Title 1, Canon 6.2) to keep the Bishop apprised of their ongoing ministry. "Every Bishop, Presbyter, or Deacon whose report is not included in a parochial report shall also report on the exercise of such office, and if there has been none the courses or reasons which have prevented the same." *Note: Deacons, by definition, cannot be non-parochial in the Diocese of Virginia since they are appointed by the bishop to serve in congregations.*

Non-Parochial Clergy are required to complete this report form and return it to the Office of the Bishop by January 10 of each year.
