WHEREAS Lois was a primary force for Good Shepherd's commitment to FISH of Clarke County (an interfaith food and clothing distribution charity), organizing church fundraisers and food donations, coordinating church volunteers for preparing and distributing boxed lunches, and sharing Christian fellowship with those who sought help from FISH, and

WHEREAS the Church of the Good Shepherd, inspired by her life, commitment, and faith has adopted a new mission statement: Follow Christ. Welcome All. Serve Humbly, be it therefore

RESOLVED that the 231st Annual Convention of the Diocese of Virginia gives thanks for the life and ministry of Lois Ann McCarty Tapscott and acknowledges the lasting impact that the faith, love, and commitment of a single person can have on a congregation, and be it further
