- January: Review clergy compensation with CPG
- March 1: Parochial Reports due
- Mid-May: Covenantal giving responses
- August 31: Congregation audits due
- Mid-September: COLA & Insurance Rates Published
- Oct/Nov: Medical Trust open enrollment
- December: Renew clergy housing resolution
- December: Review parochial report login credentials.

#### **Changes to the Parochial Report**

- Shorter!
- Instructions in-line with questions
- Accommodates non-traditional forms of community
- Ties in with online parish register
- In-Depth Video from Episcopal Parish Network
- Download & review the new form here

### Audits, gotta <del>love</del> do 'em

- Canonically required
- All funds of the church, including the church alms account
- Outside firm: Never required; BP is to use one at transitions
- Short form for budgets under \$150,000
- You will need your audits to be current to apply for church debt and diocesan grants

#### **Parochial Report Notes**

- Make sure you have access to the report. If not:
  - Try resetting the password via "I forgot my password" link
  - If that fails, contact <u>Sabrina LaFleur</u> for a full reset
- If you cannot complete the report online:
  - Let us know as soon as possible
  - We will have to enter it here, so we will need lead time to get the forms out to you and receive them back
- Last year's data is not prepopulated
  - You can download all your data back to 1998
- Make every effort to complete both parts of the report
  - 2023 full completion: 88%, partial completion 94%
- If you are not done by March 1, don't panic
  - The system does not lock until April 30
- Please submit by April 15

### **Tax Exempt Status**

- Only the Treasurer's Office of TEC can certify a congregations 501c3 status, via an association letter.
- Congregations generally aren't incorporated and therefore will not have Articles of Incorporation
- Our corporate form is "Unincorporated Religious Association"
- Use Virginia Constitution & Canons in place of bylaws
- "Beneficial Owner" use senior warden or trustee

### Property, Trustees, and Vestries

- In VA, parish property is held in trust for the Diocese by parish trustees.
- <u>Canonical processes</u> for alienation of property. 15.2 applies in most cases.
- Trustees have ONE job: Hold real property for the parish.
- Norm: 3 trustees.
